American Standard is pleased to announce the release of software version 5.5 for the following connected controls:

- ACONT824
- ACONT850
- AZON1050



All 824, 850 and 1050 controls connected to Nexia smart home will be upgraded to version 5.5 software between **January 17th and January 30th**. The upgrade process will begin by upgrading a small number of controls on January 17th and progressively increase the number each day until all connected controls are upgraded.

Version 5.5 software includes the following:

- Nexia Diagnostics fixes

A message advising homeowners about the new energy saving options will appear on each control's home screen immediately following installation of the v5.5 upgrade. The message will only appear if scheduling was not enabled prior to the upgrade. Selecting one of the new energy savings options is as simple as pressing the option desired or pressing cancel to return to the home screen.
